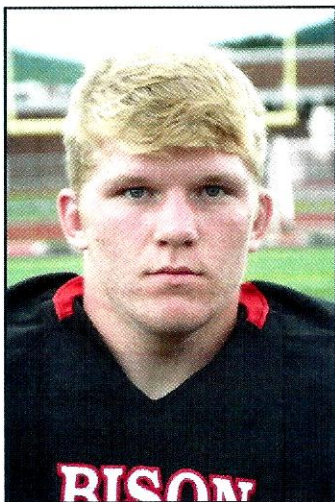


We Are Proud To Salute:

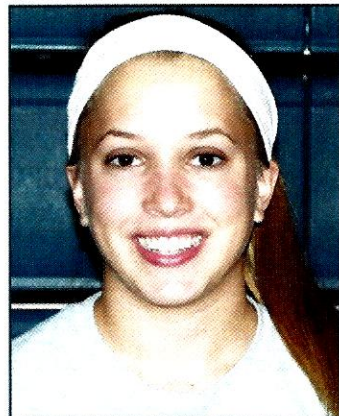
