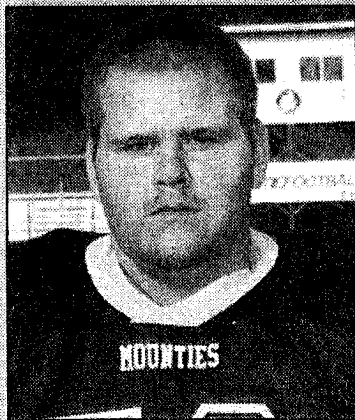

Philipsburg-Osceola football player Mike Sabol has been named The Progress' Male Athlete of the Week for the week ending Oct. 21.

Sabol plays on both the offensive and defensive lines for the Mounties and had his usual dominant performance in P-O's 33-0 thrashing of Lewistown. Sabol led an offensive line that rushed for 300 yards on 39 carries and a defensive line that gave up just 15 yards on the ground on 29 attempts. He also had a sack against the Panthers.
