


Curwensville High School freshman wrestler Derek Brothers has been named The Progress' Athlete of the Week for the week ending March 3.

Brothers won the 103-pound title at the Northwest Regional Class AA Tournament Saturday at Sharon High School, scoring a 5-2 decision over Ridgway's Colby Pisani in a rematch of the District 9 title bout. Brothers notched a 2-0 win over Fort LeBoeuf's Kilian Hiner in the semifinals.

"It was a big day for him," Curwensville head coach Duane Wriglesworth said. "A lot of people didn't expect him to win. He wasn't even picked to make it out of regionals by some of the rankings, but he won. He just doesn't quit. That sums it up. He just keeps coming at you and wrestles a full



six minutes."

Brothers (30-6) continues season march his post Thursday at the PIAA Tournament in Hershey, matching up with North Star's Joe Lascari.

Curwensville High School sophomore girls basketball player Hannah Walls has been named The Progress' Female Athlete of the Week for the week ending in Mar. 3. Walls tallied a career- and

game-high 19 points on Friday in Curwensville's District 9 class AA Championship tilt with Karns City.

On the season, Walls has racked up seven double-digit games, and is averaging 6.5 points per game heading into the Lady Tide's PIAA first-round game with Greensburg Central Catholic.

"Hannah really stepped up big for us," said Curwensville coach Vic Gearhart, "She had her career-high in the championship game. It was a game where the other team's defense stymied Danielle Struble and Jackie White and we needed someone to step up and she did that for us.



"It was just a great effort on her part, and the shots that she made were quality shots. We knew all along that Hannah had that kind of potential -she had several double-digit games this season. She's done a good job rebounding this season and that's been key to her
